

PHOENIX TARGET RIFLE CLUB Presents

COST: \$30 per shooter

Lower Light Range, Phoenix Target Rifle Club rooms

715am registration, 745am shooting position allocation

815am Competition commencement at 1000 metre range.

TOTAL of 2 rounds consisting of:

ROUND 1 - 12 shots in 12 minutes, to hit the target, at 1km (1000 metres).

1 confirmed hit is all you need to go through to the next round.

ROUND 2 – 6 shots in 6 minutes, to hit the target as many times as possible.

The second round is won, and determines the ultimate winner, being the shooter that gets the most confirmed hits on target.

Shoot off for winner (if needed): Should there be multiple shooters with the same score on the second round, a Bisley style shoot off will be conducted to determine the winner. If you hit the target and the other person/s do not, you are the winner!

Prize: The prize for the winner will be \$100 cash and a uniquely made perpetual trophy.

Second Chance round: If you are unlucky and have no hits on the first round of 12, you will have the opportunity to win back your entry fee!

All shooters that did not get a hit in the first round will have 2 shots on a cardboard target. Consisting of 1 sighter and 1 scoring shot. The shooter confirmed to be the closest to the X will win.

Rules of the competition:

Shooting positions will be drawn out of a hat 15 minutes prior to start time. You can employ the help of another person as a spotter to help guide you onto the target. This person will be behind the shooter using a spotting scope (if you do not have one, I have one that can be used)

You may use any calibre that can make that distance, and any front and rear rest of your choosing. There will be 5 flags put up for wind at 200m intervals on 1 side of the range only at organiser's discretion.
