### FRANK BRADSHAW MEDALLION

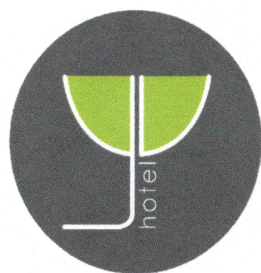
