Welcome by Adrian

Welcome all to the Members Forum. This is the first this calendar year with the second being held at Lower Light in the second half this year. A date hasn't been set as yet. Member forums are an opportunity to get feedback but particularly positive ideas and direction on what members want the board to pursue to take us forward.

I would expect everyone to respectful to each other, civil and mature at all times in their comments and suggestions.

We are happy to discuss ideas etc we but have limited time here today so would also ask that to give as many of you as possible a chance to add to the discussion that we keep the meeting moving. There will be questions that we might not be able to answer but we will take them back to the board for further clarification.

Would like to put everyone in the picture in regard to the store. We have as most would know had a significant issue with the store licensee having his dealers licence suspended. When James was appointed as store manager we were turning over approx. \$50k -60k per month which is not even enough to justify one full time position. James had built up turnover where it had got to a level that was beyond one person and enough to take on at least a part time assistant. This was discussed at board level in the month preceding James's suspension.

We appointed a new manager in early December and applied for Nominee status on 7/12/23 but couldn't get SAPOL approval until late January as SAPOL have only one person processing dealer applications and they went on annual leave from mid December until mid January and despite contacting SAPOL many times and pleading our case we were informed that 'It will be taken care of in due course'

We are still pressing ahead with putting another person in the store as an obvious plan for redundancy should something similar be it sickness or something similar happen again.

I would like to kick discussions of with a few topics from the board and then we will open it up for broader discussion

- Tumby raised concern that clubs need plenty of notice about what SARA fees will so they have time to gather from members Adrian said we will get it out ASAP
