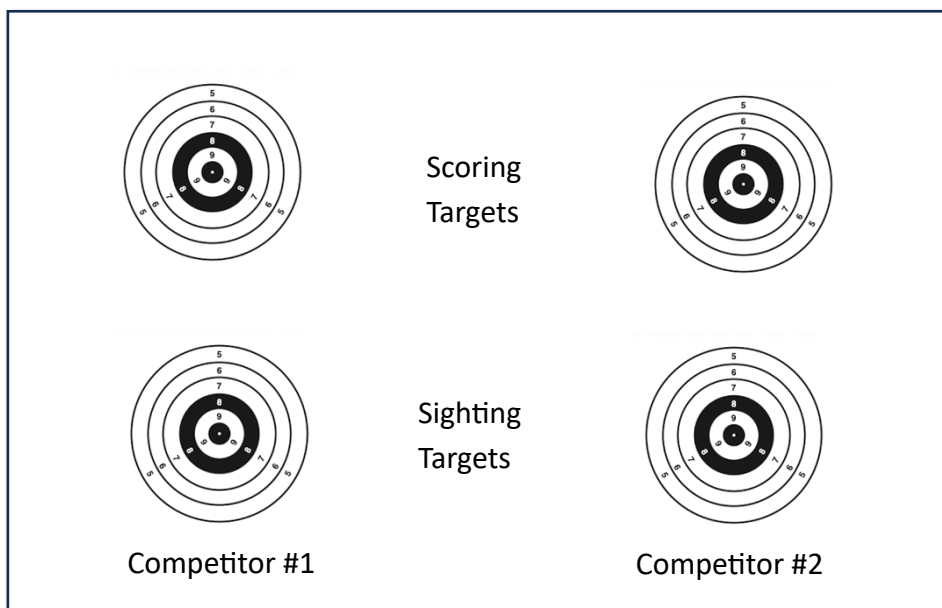
RIMFIRE CHALLENGE

Sunday 7th June 2026

Commencing at 9:30am sharp at Lower Light Rifle Range

ENTRY FEE \$15

- Production Class (PC) and Production Class Open (PCO) rimfire rifles may be used.
- The course of fire will be 2 rounds of 10 shot strings on Rimfire Targets at approximately 110 metres distance. A 3rd round will be shot if time permits.
- Course of fire is: 2 minutes for unlimited sighters on the lower target (see picture below); after a short break, the Range Officer (RO) will signal commencement of the scoring round, consisting of 10 minutes for 10 shots to count on the upper target.



- Squadding will be decided on the mound by the RO prior to commencement of the match. Two shooters shall shoot simultaneously on a single target frame. Three target frames will be available.

- All competitors shall shoot from the prone position. Bipods (Harris, Atlas or similar) and rear sandbags may be used (F-Class bipods & machine rests are excluded). Bipods shall not be placed on the shooting mat. A sling may be used as an alternative to a bipod/rear rest combination
- Specialist shooting mats and groundsheets are permitted.
- Any sight may be used, including magnifying or telescopic up to a maximum magnification of 25X (times). Any telescopic sights with greater magnification must be set to a maximum of 25X for the duration of the match.
- Competitors shall supply their own ammunition. .22 Rimfire (short, subsonic, hunting and target) ammunition only shall be used (.22 Magnums and .17 HMR etc. are not permitted).
- Magazines may be used. All magazines must be loaded and unloaded on the mound prior to and after the shooting detail.
- Magazines shall only be inserted into the rifle when the shooter is in the firing position and the “COMMENCE FIRING” command has been given by the RO.
- On completion of the detail, the action of the rifle is to be opened, the bolt and magazine removed and the chamber and magazine are to be inspected to ensure that both are free from live rounds and empty cases. Once confirmed, the Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is to be inserted.
- Following completion of each round, shooters will retire from the mound and following the direction of the RO, retrieve their own targets, sign them and return them to the Range Officer. They will also put up new targets for the next group.
- Entry restricted to S.A.R.A. Members only.
- The Light River RC organisers reserve the right to alter the program without notice.
- This match is a trial to gauge the interest and practicality for Rimfire matches at Lower Light. Competition will be for HONOR only – no prizes.
- Attendees will have to provide their own food and drink.
